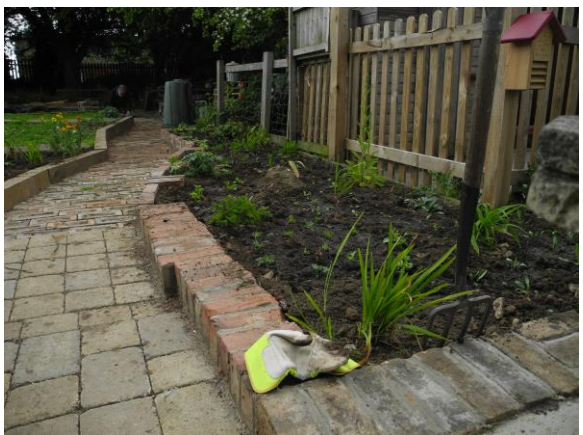




## Hungate Garden Project
