



Would you like to be sponsored for the Rotary Youth Leadership (RYLA) summer programme 2020

To qualify:

- You must be between the ages of 16 & 17 (under 18) at the time of the course.
- Live in the approximate geographic area between Towton in the north, Knottingley in the south, and Aberford/Fairburn in the west and Church Fenton/Hillam in the east. Or attend Sherburn in Elmet or Knottingley high schools. We also welcome applicants who attend Guides/Rangers and Scouts.
- Send an email by the 15th November, stating in no more than 100 words why you would like to be selected for the 2020 Rotary District 1040 Youth leadership skills development programme, together with your contact details to Ian Curran, Youth Development Officer, Osgoldcross and Elmet Rotary Club, email – curran.ian@virgin.net (contact number 07912 074847)

What happens next:

- All applications will be reviewed by Osgoldcross & Elmet Rotary Club, if successful you will be invited to an interview on the Wednesday 20th November 2019 at Monk Fryston Hall Hotel, between 6pm and 8pm (please bring along a parent or guardian) you will be informed of the timeslot.
- The interview will be by a formal panel and last around 15 – 20 minutes, you will be asked questions about yourself, your studies, hobbies, and why you would like to attend the course.
- All candidates get an opportunity to gain experience by undertaking a formal interview, and gain feedback. You will be informed of the outcome within five days.
- If you are successful, the Rotary club will sponsor and pay for you to attend the six-day RYLA District 1040 leadership skills training course, in addition transport to/from the venue in West Yorkshire will be provided. Note: It is important that if you are successful that you commit to attending the course as the Rotary Club fully fund your place.

Preliminary Course Information:

- There will be two RYLA courses in 2020 the dates for these are,
- Course 1 – Saturday 25th July to Friday 31st July 2020
- Course 2 Saturday 1st August to Friday 7th August 2020
- The course is run and operated by Rotary District 1040, with the support of a professional leadership development and coaching organisation, the course has been running for over 20 years and over 1000 young people from Yorkshire have completed the programme before commencing further Education or employment.
